

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is hiring Customs and Border Protection Officers to work for one of the Department of Homeland Security's largest agencies. CBP's priority mission is protecting our nation's borders by keeping terrorists and their weapons out of the United States.

Become part of a dynamic team working in a fast-paced environment where every day presents a new challenge. CBP Officers use state-of-the-art technology and training at more than 300 ports of entry located at international airports, seaports and land borders throughout the United States, deterring illegal entry to our country, intercepting contraband, and interdicting agricultural pests and potential diseases.

KEY REQUIREMENTS

- > Candidates must be referred for selection prior to their 37th birthday (waiver for qualified veterans)
- > Be a U.S. citizen and a resident for the past three years
- > Have a valid state driver's license
- > Pass a written exam, medical exam, physical fitness tests, video-based test and drug test
- > Pass a thorough background investigation and polygraph examination

Successful candidates receive 17-19 weeks of classroom and field training at the CBP Academy, Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) in Glynco, Ga.


- > Job Security
